Immersion 1 - Turumtruum Mogara (Thunder Rain) Experience





This is truly the ultimate dreaming immersion for your business associates, staff and guests leaving lasting memories of your event.

-  A didgeridoo player will be available to welcome guests to your event.
-  A welcome to country speech performed by a local indigenous elder
-  A Smoking ceremony accompanied by a didgeridoo master. We have a contingency plan for non smoking cleansing ceremony.
-  A concert-style dance show will follow with a song man, didgeridoo player, four dancers performing traditional dance featuring native animals, dreamtime stories and song-lines through movement in full indigenous dress.
-  Audience participation in dance if required and photo opportunities available.

Cost: start from \$6000+GST *Travel and **Rehearsal costs may apply.

Immersion 2 - Kakurri (Moon) Experience


This is truly the dreaming spectacular for your business associates, staff and guests, leaving lasting memories of your event. This is a full scale concert style performance.

-  A didgeridoo player will be available to welcome guests to your event.
-  Either a welcome to country speech performed by a local indigenous elder OR a smoking ceremony accompanied by a didgeridoo master.
-  A concert-style dance show will follow with a song man, didgeridoo player, four dancers performing traditional dance featuring native animals, dreamtime stories and song-lines through movement in full indigenous dress.
-  Audience participation in dance if required and photo opportunities available.

Cost: start from \$5500+GST *Travel and **Rehearsal costs may apply.

Immersion 3 - Birra (Sky) Corroboree

A corroboree is an event where Australian first nations people interact with the dreaming through dance, music and traditional ochre markings.


-  Traditional aboriginal song and dance featuring either our mens troupe or our women's troupe and with spiritual language and song, a didgeridoo master with 4 dancers performing traditional aboriginal dance and song which tell stories. A mesmerising indigenous performance that will totally captivate your guests!

Cost: start from \$4800+GST *Travel and **Rehearsal costs may apply.

Immersion 4 - Groman Mini Corroboree

A corroboree is an event where Australian first nations people interact with the dreaming through dance, music and costume.

-  Traditional aboriginal song and dance consisting of spiritual language song man, a didgeridoo master with 2 dancer performing traditional aboriginal dance and song which tell stories. A mesmerising indigenous performance that will totally captivate your guests!




Cost: start from \$4000+GST *Travel and **Rehearsal costs may apply.

Immersion 5 - Bowaiya (Turtle)

-  A local elder will give a traditional Welcome to Country
-  Didgeridoo master performs his unique experience with animals and stories through the didgeridoo he will work with our
-  Spiritual Song-man who delivers aboriginal language in powerful song-lines and clap sticks while sharing with the audience the meanings of these performances.
-  Traditional Smoking Ceremony cleansing spirits, the land and people for new beginnings. We have a contingency plan for non smoking cleansing ceremony.




Cost: start from \$3800+GST *Travel and **Rehearsal costs may apply.

Immersion 6 - Nguyi or Nuyi (Emu)

-  Didgeridoo master performs his unique experience with animals and stories through the didgeridoo he will work with our
-  Spiritual Song-man who delivers aboriginal language in powerful song-lines and clap sticks while sharing with the audience the meanings of these performances.
-  Welcome To Country delivered by a local elder or a Traditional Smoking Ceremony cleansing spirits, the land and people for new beginnings. We have a contingency plan for non smoking cleansing ceremony.

Cost: start from \$3100+GST *Travel and **Rehearsal costs may apply..

Immersion 7 - Giwar (Goanna)

-  A local elder delivers a traditional Welcome to Country speech.
-  Didgeridoo master performs his unique experience with animals and stories through the didgeridoo
-  Traditional Smoking Ceremony cleansing spirits, the land and people for new beginnings. We have a contingency plan for non smoking cleansing ceremony.

Cost: start from \$2750+GST *Travel and **Rehearsal costs may apply.

Immersion 8 - Dūñ (Smoking) Ceremony with Yidaki (Didgeridoo)



One of our Turrbal and Yuggera spiritual leaders will perform a cleansing smoking ceremony with selected eucalyptus leaves in a Coolamon, cleansing the ground, buildings and allowing people to brush the smoke over their heads if they wish for cleansing past and starting fresh beginnings.



Traditional and contemporary master solo didgeridoo performance. One master in traditional costume, performing traditional and contemporary didgeridoo sounds and rhythms.

Immersion 10 - Welcome To Country with Didgeridoo



Engage a local elder to deliver a traditional Welcome to Country speech which is the respectful way for thousands of years to welcome people to the land they walk upon. Performed on the stage or where you require at your event.



Traditional and contemporary master solo didgeridoo performance. One master in traditional costume, performing traditional and contemporary didgeridoo sounds and rhythms.

Cost: start from \$2300+GST *Travel and **Rehearsal costs may apply.

Immersion 11 - Dūñ (Smoking) Ceremony



One of the Turrbal or Yuggera spiritual leaders will perform a cleansing smoking ceremony with select medicinal eucalyptus leaves in a Coolamon. Cleansing the ground, buildings and allowing people to brush the smoke over their heads if they wish for cleansing the past and with starting fresh beginnings.



We have a contingency plan for non smoking cleansing ceremony.

Cost: start from \$1400+GST to \$3500 *Travel and **Rehearsal costs may apply. Performer in full traditional.

Immersion 12 - Welcome To Country



Engage a local elder to deliver a traditional Welcome to Country speech which is the respectful way for thousands of years to welcome people to the land they walk upon

Cost: start from \$1100+GST *Travel and **Rehearsal costs may apply. performer in full traditional.

Immersion 13 - The Yidaki (Didgeridoo) Experience



Traditional and contemporary master solo yidaki (didgeridoo) performance. Performed in traditional lap lap and ochre body paints, performing traditional and contemporary didgeridoo sounds and rhythms.

Cost: start from \$1200+GST *Travel and **Rehearsal costs may apply.

Immersion 14 - Mirringim (Stars) Experience



Yidaki (Didgeridoo) master performs his unique experience with native animal sounds and stories through the didgeridoo with lots of interaction.



Includes Story Telling, hands on experience with Artefacts, Weaponry, Bush Survival experience.

Cost: start from \$1600+GST 13 years of age and under

Cost: start from \$2500+GST 14 years to adult

Workshop 1 - Art On Canvas Team #1 purchased workshop


 Art Work Shop - Learn aboriginal symbols with our indigenous facilitator and create your dreamtime story with all your team members or community to paint 3m x 2m canvas (Canvas can go up to 9 m long. Add \$1000+GST per lineal metre.) Can be cut into smaller framable canvases for framing once painted)


 All Completed art works will remain the property of you the purchaser to use in your space, a community space or be auctioned for charity.

 We supply canvas, paints, brushes and symbol sheet plus tutor and story teller

Cost: start from \$6000+GST minimum cost for 3m x 2m Canvas *Travel costs may apply.

Workshop 2 - Art Workshop Individual

 Art Work Shop - Learn aboriginal symbols with our indigenous facilitator and create your own individual dreamtime story with your team members or community while they create their own.

 We supply A3 quality art paper, all paints, brushes and symbol sheet plus tutor and story teller

 All Completed art works will remain the property of the individual artists to take home.

Cost: start from \$3500+GST minimum cost for a groups up to 50pax and \$25 per person there-after
*Travel costs may apply.

Workshop 3 - Paint Your Own Boomerang

 Learn aboriginal symbols and create your dreamtime story

 each attendee will then paint their own story on a boomerang which they take home as a keep sake gift

 We supply boomerangs, paints, brushes and symbol sheet plus tutor and story teller

Cost: start from \$2800+GST minimum cost for a groups up to 50pax plus \$20 per person there-after
