Immersion 1 - bulburai (Ngambri) Thunderstorm - Aboriginal Complete Concert Experience

Aboriginal Cultural Immersions





Our ultimate Immersive performance live in concert for events where you want to impress your Australian or International guests and business associates - from the Office to conference and stadium-sized events

-  A didgeridoo player will be available to welcome guests to your event.
-  + A welcome to country speech performed by a local indigenous elder
-  + A Ngunnawal or Ngambri spiritual leader will perform a smoking ceremony with selected eucalyptus leaves in a Coolamon.
-  + A concert-style dance show featuring a song man, didgeridoo player, and dancers performing traditional dances that incorporate native animal and hunting dance, Dreaming stories, and song-lines through movement in full indigenous dress.
-  Audience participation in dance if required, and photo opportunities are available.

Cost: starts from \$6000 + GST. Travel and Rehearsal costs may apply.

Immersion 2 - Thirriwirri (Ngambri-Ngunnawal): Ironbark tree Concert Experience


A smaller version of Immersion 1, in concert performance.

-  A didgeridoo player will be available to welcome guests to your event.
-  + Either a Welcome To Country or Acknowledgement To Country speech, OR a smoking ceremony accompanied by the didgeridoo master.
-  + A concert-style dance show featuring a song man, didgeridoo player, and dancers performing traditional dances that incorporate native animal and hunting dance, Dreaming stories, and song-lines through movement in full indigenous dress.
-  Audience participation in dance if comfortable, and photo opportunities are available.

Cost: starts from \$ 5000+GST. Travel and rehearsal costs may apply.

Immersion 3 - Ganjgruŋ (Ngambri) Kangaroo Corroboree

A corroboree is an event where Australian First Nations people interact with the Dreaming through dance, music and traditional ochre markings.

-  Traditional Aboriginal song and dance featuring indigenous men and/or women, accompanied by spiritual language and song. A didgeridoo master performs alongside our songman and dancers, telling stories through traditional Aboriginal dance and music. A mesmerising indigenous performance that will captivate your guests!

Cost: starts from \$4500 +GST *Travel and **Rehearsal costs may apply.

Immersion 4 - Malunggang (Ngunnawal): Platypus - Mini Corroboree

A smaller version of Immersion 3.

- Traditional Aboriginal song and dance consist of spiritual language, a didgeridoo master, and dancers performing traditional Aboriginal dance and music, which tell stories. A mesmerising indigenous performance that will captivate your guests!

Cost: starts from \$3900 +GST *Travel and **Rehearsal costs may apply.

Immersion 5 - Mugga (Ngunnawal): Snake.- Complete Cleansing and Healing

- A local Ngunnawal or Ngambri custodian will give a traditional Welcome to Country
- + Didgeridoo master performs his unique experience with animals and stories through the didgeridoo; he will work with our
- + Spiritual Song-man who delivers aboriginal language in powerful song-lines and clapsticks while sharing with the audience the meanings of these performances.
- + A Ngunnawal or Ngambri spiritual leader will perform a smoking ceremony with selected eucalyptus leaves in a Coolamon.

Cost: starts from \$4500 +GST *Travel and **Rehearsal costs may apply.

Immersion 6 - Diktigan (Ngunnawal) Kingfisher - The Traditional Ceremony

- A local elder delivers a traditional Welcome to Country speech.
- The didgeridoo master shares his unique experiences with hunting, animal movements and stories through the didgeridoo.
- A traditional Smoking Ceremony cleanses spirits, the land, and people for new beginnings. We have a contingency plan for a non-smoking cleansing ceremony.



Cost: starts from \$3500 +GST *Travel and **Rehearsal costs may apply..

Immersion 7 - Gauwatj ((Ngambri) Echidna Traditional Ceremony 2

- + Didgeridoo master performs his unique experience with animals and stories through the didgeridoo; he will work with our
- + Spiritual Song-man who delivers aboriginal language in powerful song-lines and clapsticks while sharing with the audience the meanings of these performances.
- + A Ngunnawal or Ngambri spiritual leader will perform a smoking ceremony with selected eucalyptus leaves in a Coolamon.

Cost: starts from \$3500 +GST *Travel and **Rehearsal costs may apply.

Immersion 8 - Smoking Ceremony with Yidaki (Didgeridoo)



-  A Ngunnawal or Ngambri spiritual leader will perform a smoking ceremony with selected eucalyptus leaves in a Coolamon.
-  Traditional and contemporary master solo didgeridoo performance. One master in traditional costume, performing traditional and modern didgeridoo sounds and rhythms.

Cost: starts from \$2500 +GST *Travel and **Rehearsal costs may apply

Immersion 9 - Welcome To Country & Smoking Ceremony - Dumbug (Ngambri) Smoke

-  Engage a local Ngunnawal or Ngambri traditional owner to deliver a Welcome to Country speech, the respectful way of thousands of years, to welcome people to the land they walk upon.
-  A Ngunnawal or Ngambri spiritual leader will perform a smoking ceremony with selected eucalyptus leaves in a Coolamon.



Cost: starts from \$2500 +GST *Travel and **Rehearsal costs may apply.

Immersion 10 - Welcome To Country with Didgeridoo Experience

-  Engage a local elder to deliver a traditional Welcome to Country speech, a respectful way to welcome people to the land their ancestors have walked for thousands of years. Performed on the stage or where you require at your event.
-  Traditional and contemporary master solo didgeridoo performance. One master in traditional costume, performing traditional and contemporary didgeridoo sounds and rhythms.


Cost: starts from \$2500 +GST *Travel and **Rehearsal costs may apply.

Immersion 11 - Dumbug (Ngambri) Smoking Ceremony - Office / Outdoor / Staged Events

-  One of the Ngunnawal or Ngambri spiritual leaders will perform a cleansing smoking ceremony with select medicinal eucalyptus leaves in a Coolamon. This Smoking Ceremony is perfect for Office / Outdoor / Staged events, through the audience or on stage.
-  We have a contingency plan for a non-smoking cleansing ceremony.

Cost: start from \$1300 +GST to \$2400 +GST *Travel and **Rehearsal costs may apply

Immersion 12 - Complete Cleansing and Healing Ceremony - Construction/Buildings

-  Ngunnawal or Ngambri spiritual leaders will perform a cleansing ceremony with select medicinal eucalyptus leaves in a Coolamon. This Immersion is a complete area cleansing the ground, buildings, and your people may brush the smoke over their heads if they wish. Perfect for breaking ground, new buildings, or cleansing old buildings or premises of past doings and bringing a fresh start to the new venture on old ground.

Cost: starts from \$2500 + GST to \$4000 + GST to bring in a language songman, which, with the smoking, adds further spirituality and narration to the healing. Performed in full traditional dress and ochres.

Immersion 13 - Welcome To Country



Engage a local elder to deliver a traditional Welcome to Country speech, a respectful way of welcoming people to the land their ancestors have walk upon for thousands of years.

Cost: starts from \$1200+GST *Travel and **Rehearsal costs may apply.

Immersion 13 - The Yidaki (Didgeridoo) Experience



Traditional and contemporary master solo yidaki (didgeridoo) performance. Performed in traditional lap lap and ochre body paints, performing traditional and contemporary didgeridoo sounds and rhythms.

Cost: starts from \$1500+GST *Travel and **Rehearsal costs may apply.

Workshops

Workshop 1 - Art On Canvas Team - Our #1 purchased workshop



Art Workshop - Learn Aboriginal symbols with our Indigenous facilitator, and, with your team members or community, create your Dreamtime story to paint a quality canvas.



All completed artworks will remain the property of you, the purchaser, to use in your space, a community space or be auctioned for charity.



We supply canvas, paints, brushes and a symbol sheet, plus a tutor and storyteller.

Cost: Starts from \$5500+GST, covering a 3m x 1.8m Canvas. Add \$1000+GST per lineal metre.) Travel costs may apply over 100km outside of the Sydney CBD.

Workshop 2 - Art Workshop Individual



Art Workshop - Learn Aboriginal symbols with our Indigenous facilitator and create your own Dreamtime story with your team members or community, while they create their own.



We supply A3-quality art paper or mini canvas pads, all paints and brushes, a symbol sheet, plus a tutor and storyteller.



All completed artworks will remain the property of the individual artists and may be taken home.

Cost: A3 Art paper starts from \$3800+GST, covering up to the first 50 pax, and \$25 per person thereafter. Mini Canvas Panel, approximately 25 x 30cm, starts from \$4500+GST and \$30 per person thereafter.

Workshop 3 - Paint Your Own Boomerang

- Learn Aboriginal symbols and create your Dreamtime story
- Each attendee will then paint their own story on a boomerang, which they take home as a keepsake gift
- We supply boomerangs, paints, brushes and a symbol sheet, plus a tutor and a story storyteller

Cost: starts from \$2900+GST, covering up to the first 50pax, plus \$20 per person thereafter - 45 to 60 minutes

*Travel and costs may apply 100km outside of Sydney.

Workshop 4 - Dyurra (Ngunnawal) Stars

- Yidaki (Didgeridoo) master shares his unique Yidaki experience, including its history, how it is made, and a masterclass performance blending native animal sounds, healing vibrations and stories through the didgeridoo, engaging the audience in a lively interaction.
- Ancient Storytelling Yarning Circle workshop featuring an in-depth talk on the creation and amazing beings that existed before the time of man.
- Hands-on knowledge and handling experience with Artefacts, Weaponry, and Bush Survival tools.

Cost: starts from \$4500+GST

*Travel and **Rehearsal costs may apply.

Workshop 5 - Yumalundi (Ngunnawal) Hello Rotation Workshop

- Rotation 1 - Art Workshop
- Rotation 2 - Bush Survival, Weaponry and Artefacts Workshop
- Rotation 3 - Didge and Dance Workshop

3 Groups will rotate over 3 hours (45-minute sessions) to work on each station, each with an Aboriginal facilitator sharing culture and knowledge at each station.

Cost: Starts from \$8000+GST, including up to 90 participants; \$50 per participant thereafter.
