Immersion 1 - Tapa Wardli Pari (Milky Way) Ceremony and Performance

The ultimate in-concert immersion and live performance concert for your business associates, staff and guests, leaving lasting memories of your event.







-  A didgeridoo player will be available to welcome guests to your event.
-  A welcome to country speech performed by a local Aboriginal Elder
-  A Smoking ceremony accompanied by a didgeridoo master. We have a contingency plan for a non-smoking cleansing ceremony.
-  A concert-style dance show will follow, featuring a songman, a didgeridoo player, and dancers performing traditional dances, with native animal and Dreaming stories all in traditional dress.
-  Audience participation in dance is available if suitable, and photo opportunities are available.

Cost: starts at \$6000 + GST.

Immersion 2 - Wirtu (Southern Cross) Ceremony and Performance


Immersion 2 the same as Immersion 1, except you choose between a Welcome to Country or a Smoking ceremony

-  A didgeridoo player will be available to welcome guests to your event.
-  Choose between a Welcome to Country speech performed by a local Aboriginal Elder OR a smoking ceremony accompanied by a didgeridoo master.
-  A concert-style dance show will follow, featuring a songman, a didgeridoo player, and dancers performing traditional dances, with native animal and Dreaming stories all in traditional Indigenous dress.
-  Audience participation in dance is available if suitable, and photo opportunities are available.

Cost: starts at \$5500 + GST

Immersion 3 - Ngayirda (Sky) Corroboree

A corroboree is an event where Australian First Nations people interact with the Dreaming through dance, music and traditional ochre markings.

-  Traditional Aboriginal song and dance with a spiritual songman singing in language, a didgeridoo master and traditional dancers performing in concert, presenting local songlines.

Cost: starts at \$4800 + GST

Immersion 4 - Nantu (Grey Kangaroo) Mini Corroboree

A corroboree is an event where Australian First Nations people interact with the Dreaming through dance, music and costume.

- Traditional Aboriginal song and dance, featuring a didgeridoo master with 2 dancers performing traditional Aboriginal dance and song that tell stories. A mesmerising indigenous performance that will totally captivate your guests!

Cost: starts at \$4,000 + GST.

Immersion 5 - Kurraka (Magpie)

- A local Aboriginal Elder will give a traditional Welcome to Country
- Didgeridoo master performs his unique experience with animals and stories through the didgeridoo; he will work with our
- Spiritual Song-man who delivers aboriginal language in powerful song-lines and clap sticks while sharing with the audience the meanings of these performances.
- A traditional Smoking Ceremony cleanses spirits, the land, and people for new beginnings. We have a contingency plan for a non-smoking cleansing ceremony.

Cost: starts at \$3800 + GST.

Immersion 6 - Kardi (Emu)

- Didgeridoo master performs his unique experience with animals and stories through the didgeridoo. He will work with our
- Spiritual Song-man who delivers aboriginal language in powerful song-lines and clap sticks while sharing with the audience the meanings of these performances.
- Welcome to Country, delivered by a local Aboriginal Elder, or a Traditional Smoking Ceremony that cleanses spirits, the land, and people for new beginnings. We have a contingency plan for a non-smoking cleansing ceremony.

Cost: starts at \$3100 + GST.

Immersion 7 - Puntunya (Goanna)

- A local Aboriginal Elder delivers a traditional Welcome to Country speech.
- Didgeridoo master performs his unique experience with animals and stories through the didgeridoo.
- A traditional Smoking Ceremony cleanses spirits, the land, and people for new beginnings. We have a contingency plan for a non-smoking cleansing ceremony.

Cost: starts from \$2750 + GST.

Immersion 8 - Puiya (Smoking) Ceremony with Yidaki (Didgeridoo)



One of our Kurna or Peramangk spiritual leaders will perform a cleansing smoking ceremony with selected eucalyptus leaves in a Coolamon, cleansing the ground and buildings, and allowing people to brush the smoke over their heads if they wish for cleansing past and starting fresh beginnings.



Traditional and contemporary master solo didgeridoo performance. One master in traditional costume, performing traditional and contemporary didgeridoo sounds and rhythms.

Immersion 9 - Welcome To Country & Smoking Ceremony



Engage a local Aboriginal Elder to deliver a traditional Welcome to Country speech, a respectful way to welcome people to the land they have walked for thousands of years.



One of our Kurna or Peramangk spiritual leaders will perform a cleansing smoking ceremony with selected eucalyptus leaves in a Coolamon, cleansing the ground, buildings and allowing people to brush the smoke over their heads if they wish for cleansing past and starting fresh beginnings.

Cost: starts at \$2400 + GST.

Immersion 10 - Welcome To Country with Didgeridoo



Engage a local Aboriginal Elder to deliver a traditional Welcome to Country speech, a respectful way to welcome people to the land they have walked for thousands of years. Performed on the stage or where you require at your event.



Traditional and contemporary master solo didgeridoo performance. One master in traditional costume, performing traditional and contemporary didgeridoo sounds and rhythms.

Cost: starts at \$2300 + GST.

Immersion 11 - Puiyu (Smoking/Cleansing) Ceremony



One of the Kurna or Peramangk spiritual leaders will perform a cleansing smoking ceremony with select medicinal eucalyptus leaves in a Coolamon. Cleansing the ground and buildings, and allowing people to brush the smoke from their heads if they wish, for cleansing the past and starting fresh beginnings.

Cost: starts at \$1400 + GST to \$3500 + GST dependent on needs and area size for cleansing

Immersion 12 - Marni Naa Pudni - (Welcome) To Country



Engage a local Elder to deliver a traditional Welcome to Country speech, which is the respectful way for thousands of years to welcome people to the land they walk upon

Cost: starts at \$1100 + GST.

Immersion 13 - The Yidaki (Didgeridoo) Experience



Traditional and contemporary master solo yidaki (didgeridoo) performance. Performed in traditional lap lap and ochre body paints, performing traditional and contemporary didgeridoo sounds and rhythms.

Cost: starts at \$1,400 + GST.

Immersion 14 - Purli (Star)



A Yidaki (Didgeridoo) master performs a unique experience of native animal sounds and stories through the didgeridoo, with lots of interaction.



Includes Story Telling, hands-on experience with Artefacts, Weaponry, and Bush Survival experience.

Cost: starts at \$2500 + GST

Commission an Indigenous Artist



Commission Indigenous artists to create a unique original masterpiece on canvas or directly on a wall.

Workshop 1 - Art On Canvas Team Our #1 purchased Workshop




-  Learn Aboriginal symbols with our Indigenous facilitator while working alongside your team to create a shared Aboriginal art story.
-  Together, your group will create a collaborative team artwork guided by Aboriginal art, symbols and storytelling. Completed artworks remain yours to display in your workplace or community space, or auction for charity.
-  We supply canvas, paints, brushes and symbol sheets, plus a tutor and storyteller

Cost: starts at \$5500 + GST, minimum cost for 3m x 1.8m Canvas or smaller if required.

Workshop 2 - Art Workshop Individual

-  Learn Aboriginal symbols and while yarning about local cultures, histories, to help get your team engaged to create your Aboriginal art story
-  Each attendee will paint their own story on Canvas to take home as a meaningful keepsake.
-  We supply 22cm x 30cm Canvas, paints, brushes and symbol sheets, plus a tutor and storyteller




Cost: starts at \$4000 + GST; minimum cost for a group of up to 40 pax, and \$30 per person thereafter.

Workshop 3 - Paint Your Own Boomerang

-  Learn Aboriginal symbols, yarn about local cultures and histories, and create individual artworks as part of a shared team story.
-  Each attendee will paint their own story on a boomerang to take home as a meaningful keepsake.
-  We supply boomerangs, paints, brushes and symbol sheets, plus a tutor and storyteller

Cost: starts at \$3000 + GST; minimum cost for a group of up to 50 pax, and \$25 per person thereafter.

Workshop 4 - Yarning Circle

-  Yidaki (Didgeridoo) master shares his unique Yidaki experience, including its history, how it is made, followed by an indigenous maestro performance blending native animal sounds and stories with healing vibrations through the didgeridoo, engaging the audience in a lively interaction.
-  A meaningful Yarning Circle workshop featuring an in-depth cultural talk exploring Aboriginal histories, cultural protocols, respectful engagement, and current approaches to cultural learning and training.
-  This session creates a safe, open space for conversation, reflection, and deeper understanding, helping participants connect with Aboriginal perspectives in a respectful, practical way.
