# Aboriginal Cultural Immersions

### Immersion 1 - Koori Aboriginal Complete Concert Experience





Our ultimate Immersive performance live in concert for events where you want to impress your Australian or International guests and business associates - from the Office to conference and stadium-sized events

-  A didgeridoo player will be available to welcome guests to your event.
-  + A welcome to country speech performed by a local indigenous elder
-  + A Gadigal, Bidjigal, Dharug, or Yuin cultural leader will perform a smoking ceremony with selected eucalyptus leaves in a Coolamon.
-  + A concert-style dance show featuring a song man, didgeridoo player, and dancers performing traditional dances that incorporate native animal and hunting dance, Dreaming stories, and song-lines through movement in full indigenous dress.
-  Audience participation in dance if the team is game and photo opportunities are available.

Cost: starts at \$6000 + GST.

### Immersion 2 - Mundowie (Tracking Footprint) Concert Experience


A smaller version of Immersion 1, in concert performance.

-  A didgeridoo player will be available to welcome guests to your event.
-  + Either a Welcome To Country or Acknowledgement To Country speech, OR a smoking ceremony accompanied by a didgeridoo master.
-  + A concert-style dance show featuring a song man, didgeridoo player, and dancers performing traditional dances that incorporate native animal and hunting dance, Dreaming stories, and song-lines through movement in full indigenous dress.
-  Audience participation in dance if the team is game and photo opportunities are available.

Cost: starts at \$ 5000+GST.

### Immersion 3 - Waratah Corroboree

A corroboree is an event where Australian First Nations people interact with the Dreaming through dance, music and traditional ochre markings.

-  Traditional Aboriginal song and dance featuring indigenous men and/or women, accompanied by spiritual song in language. A didgeridoo master performs alongside our songman and dancers, telling stories through traditional Aboriginal dance and music. A mesmerising indigenous performance that will captivate your guests!

Cost: starts at \$4500 +GST

#### Immersion 4 - Wirambi (Flying Fox) - Mini Corroboree

A smaller version of Immersion 3.

- Traditional Aboriginal song and dance include spiritual language, a didgeridoo master, and dancers performing traditional Aboriginal dance and music that tell stories. A mesmerising indigenous performance that will captivate your guests!

Cost: starts at \$3900 +GST

#### Immersion 5 - Kurrajong - Complete Cleansing and Healing Immersion

- A local elder will give a traditional Welcome to Country
- + Didgeridoo master performs his unique experience with animals and stories through the didgeridoo; he will work with our
- + Spiritual Song-man who delivers aboriginal language in powerful song-lines and clapsticks while sharing with the audience the meanings of these performances.
- + A Gadigal, Bidjigal, Dharug, or Yuin cultural leader will perform a smoking ceremony with selected eucalyptus leaves in a Coolamon.

Cost: starts at \$4500 +GST

#### Immersion 6 - Wobbegong - The Traditional Ceremony

- A local elder delivers a traditional Welcome to Country speech.
- The didgeridoo master shares his unique experiences with hunting, animal movements and stories through the didgeridoo.
- A traditional Smoking Ceremony cleanses spirits, the land, and people for new beginnings. We have a contingency plan for a non-smoking cleansing ceremony.



Cost: starts at \$3500 +GST

#### Immersion 7 - Wirriga male Wirrigule female (Goanna)

- + Didgeridoo master performs his unique experience with animals and stories through the didgeridoo; he will work with our
- + Spiritual Song-man who delivers aboriginal language in powerful song-lines and clapsticks while sharing with the audience the meanings of these performances.
- + A Gadigal, Bidjigal, Dharug, or Yuin cultural leader will perform a smoking ceremony with selected eucalyptus leaves in a Coolamon.

Cost: starts at \$3500 +GST



### **Immersion 8 - Smoking Ceremony with Yidaki (Didgeridoo)**

-  A Gadigal, Bidjigal, Dharug, or Yuin cultural leader will perform a smoking ceremony with selected eucalyptus leaves in a Coolamon.
-  Traditional and contemporary master solo didgeridoo performance. One master in traditional costume, performing traditional and modern didgeridoo sounds and rhythms.

Cost: starts at \$2500 + GST





### **Immersion 9 - Welcome To Country & Smoking Ceremony**

-  Engage a local Gadigal, Bidjigal, Dharug, or Yuin traditional owner to deliver a Welcome to Country speech, the respectful way of thousands of years, to welcome people to the land they walk upon.
-  A local cultural leader will perform a smoking ceremony with selected eucalyptus leaves in a Coolamon.


Cost: starts at \$2500 +GST

### **Immersion 10 - Welcome To Country with Didgeridoo Experience**

-  Engage a local elder to deliver a traditional Welcome to Country speech, a respectful way to welcome people to the land their ancestors have walked for thousands of years. Performed on the stage or where you require at your event.
-  Traditional and contemporary master solo didgeridoo performance. One master in traditional costume, performing traditional and contemporary didgeridoo sounds and rhythms.


Cost: starts at \$2500 +GST

### **Immersion 11 - Puiyu (Smoking) Ceremony - Office / Outdoor / Staged Events**

-  One of the Gadigal, Eora, Dharug or Yuin spiritual leaders will perform a cleansing smoking ceremony with select medicinal eucalyptus leaves in a Coolamon. This Smoking Ceremony is perfect for Office / Outdoor / Staged events, through the audience or on stage.


Cost: starts at \$1300 +GST to \$2400 +GST

### **Immersion 12 - Complete Puiyu Cleansing and Healing Ceremony - Construction/Buildings**

-  Gadigal, Eora, Dharug or Yuin cultural leaders will perform a cleansing ceremony with select medicinal eucalyptus leaves in a Coolamon. This Immersion is a complete area cleansing the ground, buildings, and your people may brush the smoke over their heads if they wish. Perfect for breaking ground, building new structures, or cleansing old buildings or premises of past doings, bringing a fresh start to the new venture on old ground.


Cost: starts at \$2500 + GST to \$4000 + GST, depending on the size of the area to be cleansed

## Immersion 13 - Welcome To Country

 Engage a local elder to deliver a traditional Welcome to Country speech, a respectful way to welcome people to the land their ancestors have walked for thousands of years.

Cost: starts at \$1200+GST

## Immersion 13 - The Yidaki (Didgeridoo) Experience

 Traditional and contemporary master solo yidaki (didgeridoo) performance. Performed in traditional lap lap and ochre body paints, performing traditional and contemporary didgeridoo sounds and rhythms.

Cost: starts at \$1500 + GST \*Travel and \*\*Rehearsal costs may apply.





## Workshops


Our workshops create space for conversation and offer chances to learn together at work. We love sharing stories and making sure everyone feels welcome.

The workshops are creative and fun, but more importantly, what you learn helps you understand and connect with Aboriginal histories, cultures, and peoples. The workshops are more than just paint and dance.

### Workshop 1 - Art On Canvas Team Our #1 purchased workshop

 Art Workshop - Learn Aboriginal symbols with our indigenous facilitator and create your Aboriginal art story while learning and working with your team members

 All completed artworks will remain the property of you, the purchaser, to use in your workplace, a community space, or be auctioned for charity.

 We supply canvas, paints, brushes and symbol sheets, plus a tutor and storyteller

Cost: starts at \$6000+GST, minimum cost for 3m x 1.8m Canvas \*Travel costs may apply.



## Workshop 2 - Art Workshop Individual

- Learn Aboriginal symbols and, while yarning about local culture and histories, help your team get engaged to create your Aboriginal art story, learning with your team members or community.
- We supply quality Canvas, all paints, brushes and symbol sheet, plus tutor and storyteller
- All completed artworks will remain the property of the individual artists and may be taken home.

Cost: starts from \$4000+GST; minimum cost for a group of up to the first 40 pax, and \$30 per person thereafter.

## Workshop 3 - Paint Your Own Boomerang

- Learn Aboriginal symbols and while yarning about local culture, histories, to help get your team engaged to create your Aboriginal art story
- Each attendee will then paint their own story on a boomerang, which they take home as a keepsake gift
- We supply boomerangs, paints, brushes and symbol sheets, plus a tutor and storyteller

Cost: starts at \$3000 + GST; minimum cost for a group of up to 40 pax, and \$30 per person thereafter.

## Workshop 4 - Yarning Circle

- Yidaki (Didgeridoo) master shares his unique Yidaki experience, including its history, how it is made, followed by an indigenous maestro performance blending native animal sounds and stories with healing vibrations through the didgeridoo, engaging the audience in a lively interaction.
- A meaningful Yarning Circle workshop featuring an in-depth cultural talk exploring Aboriginal histories, cultural protocols, respectful engagement, and current approaches to cultural learning and training.
- This session creates a safe, open space for conversation, reflection, and deeper understanding, helping participants connect with Aboriginal perspectives in a respectful, practical way.

45 to 90 minutes recommended - Cost: starts at \$4500+GST

## Workshop 5 - Yaama (Hello) Rotation Workshop

- Rotation 1 - Art Workshop
- Rotation 2 - Bush Survival, Weaponry and Artefacts Workshop
- Rotation 3 - Didge and Dance Workshop

3 Groups will rotate over 3 hours (45-minute sessions) to work on each station, each with an Aboriginal facilitator sharing culture and knowledge at each station.

Cost: Starts at \$ 9000 + GST, including up to the first 90 participants; \$50 per participant thereafter.
